DreamWorks & AnimAction Join Forces on UNICEF PSA

AnimAction students and crew were given the opportunity to collaborate with professionals at DreamWorks Animation on an animated PSA for UNICEF. Frank Gladstone, head of artist development at DreamWorks, developed the PSA, dealing with a child's right to a name and a nationality. AnimAction supplied the animation artists including staff and inner city high school students from the Los Angeles Unified School District to work at the DreamWorks facility on the one-week production. The spot will premiere with all of UNICEF's PSAs at the Annecy International Animated Film Festival in France. Cohen will participate on a panel at Annecy dealing with how animation can change lives.
